- Секунды**: Violas, playing a rhythmic accompaniment with dynamics *mp* and *pizz.*
- Альты**: Cellos, playing a rhythmic accompaniment with dynamics *mp* and *pizz.*
- Басы и контрабасы**: Double Basses and Contrabasses, playing a rhythmic accompaniment with dynamics *mp*.
