Psalm 29:1-4, 10

- 1. O give the LORD, you child<u>ren</u> of God, give the LORD glory and power; give the LORD the glory <u>of</u> his name. Adore the LORD, resplendent and holy.
- 2. The LORD's voice resounding <u>on</u> the waters, the LORD on the immensity of waters;
- the voice of the LORD, <u>full</u> of power, the voice of the LORD, full of splendor.
- 3. The God of <u>glory</u> thunders.
 In his temple they <u>all</u> cry: "Glory!"
 The LORD sat enthroned o<u>ver</u> the flood; the LORD sits as king for ever.

Performance Notes

The Antiphon is sung twice each time. The Alto canon may give rise to the temptation to sing the Antiphon more than twice, a temptation which should be resisted except perhaps after the final psalm verse!
